

Day 1 Viper 640 North Americans: Surprise Breeze Welcomes Competitors



MARBLEHEAD, Mass. (September 6): After months of waiting, the guns went off, and the competitors as always were overanxious. Despite a couple of general recalls, Day 1 of the Viper 640 North Americans had two races -- two more than many thought were possible given the forecast. Pieter Taselaar and Glyn Locke both had a first and a second to end Day 1 tied.



The day's forecast called for light air and as competitors launched boats into a glassed over Marblehead Harbor, there was concern that Thursday might be a bust. A light southwester began to fill after the competitors meeting, and after a short on-water postponement, the race committee cranked out two races into a breeze that tapped out at 14 knots.

“Everyone pulled together to get the entire fleet launched in time and I’m glad the breeze filled to have a great afternoon of racing.” said Class President Dawn Kozak.

Racing was tight all day in the 44-boat fleet, the largest in the class’s history, breaking the record set five months ago in Charleston. Thursday night, the fleet gathered at the famous Maddie’s Sail Loft for dinner and drinks and recapping the day. Friday’s forecast calls for moderate breeze from the west, though if seabreeze conditions fill, sailors could enjoy more champagne sailing.
