DRAFT NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 This is an ISAF Regulation 20 Category C event. All boats shall have mainsail numbers.
- 1.3 There will be no minimum or maximum crew weight limits for this regatta.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The regatta shall be open to all Viper 640 sailboats whose owner or skipper is a member of the Viper 640 Class Association.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Friday, May 29	1900	Competitors Briefing
Saturday, May 30	1100	Warning, first race
Sunday, May 31	1100	Warning, racing resumes
		No warning after 1500

As many races will be run within the time permitted as possible.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 The entry deadline is 0900 Saturday, May 30.
- 4.2 All entries are to be made on-line via the link at www.indianharboryc.com.
- 4.3 The entry fee is TBD.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on-site and on-line at www.indianharboryc.com.

6. EQUIPMENT

All boats are encouraged to carry a VHF radio.

7. RACING AREA

- 7.1 The racing area will either inside (north of) Great and Little Captain Island or in Long Island Sound south of Little Captain Island.
- 7.2 The Committee will make a 1000 courtesy announcement on VHF 72 with the course location.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 shall be a One-Turn Penalty (one tack and one gybe in the same direction) except that for rule 18 infringements, the penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty (two tacks and two gybes in the same direction). This changes RRS 44.1 and 44.2.

9. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2, shall apply. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. One completed race shall constitute a regatta.

10. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers.
