Registration:

Registration will be held Friday evening and Saturday morning at the FYC clubhouse, as outlined below.

Rules

All races will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the current prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, One Design Class rules when not in conflict with the forgoing, and FYC Sailing Instructions.

Classes and Number of Scheduled Races

- 1 - PHRF & Portsmouth: Two or more races will be attempted; Races will occur on both Saturday and Sunday.
- 1 - Fish, R-19: Three boats will constitute a class. Five or more races will be attempted.
- 2 - Viper, VX One, Ultimate 20 - Three boats will constitute a class. Five or more races will be attempted.
- 3 - Finn, Capdevielle - Three boats will constitute a class. Five races are scheduled for Capdevielle, five or more races will be attempted for Finns.
- 4 - 420's (Jr) - Three (3) boats will constitute a class. Five or more races will be attempted.
- 4 - Sunfish, Laser, Laser Radial (Jr) - Three boats will constitute a class. Five or more races will be attempted.
- 5 - Optimist R/W/B Five or more races will be attempted.
- 6 - Optimist Green. Five or more races will be attempted.

Note: 1. One race sailed will constitute a series applies to all classes.
