1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta and clinic are open to boats of the Viper 640, International 505, Lightning, 420, Laser, J24, J70 and any other class with at least 5 pre-registered boats.

Additional \$10 fee for entries received after October 27, 2014.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 10:00AM on November 8, 2014 at HYC.

6 VENUE

Races will be sailed in the vicinity of the Hampton Flats.
Launch facilities are available at Hampton Yacht Club. Please do not park trailers in the HYC parking lot. Smaller trailers may be parked in the grass lot at the south end of the property and larger trailers may be parked dry storage areas.
