- Classes:** Classes expected to compete include PHRF A, B, C, NS (double headsail allowed), One-Design classes, plus a special Cruising class. Fleets may be further sub-divided. One Design classes (monohull over 20 feet LOA) with at least six (6) registered (entry complete and fee paid) are encouraged and will race on a special One-Design course, windward-leeward courses all three days of SBRW. Cruising Class boats (non-sanctioned, single headsail only) will receive a courtesy rating which may not be appealed. The Cruising Fleet

races Saturday and Sunday only. PHRF boats must have a current valid PHRF rating certificate. PHRF and Cruising fleet boats must meet category *ChesBay* of the PHRF of the Chesapeake Safety Equipment Requirements.

Friday, May 29-Multiple windward/leeward races in Harbor

Saturday, May 30-Distance Race in Bay

Sunday, May 31-Multiple windward/leeward races off Ocean View

ONE DESIGN:

Three (3) days of multiple windward/leeward races

CRUISING: (Racing Saturday and Sunday only)

Saturday, May 30 - Distance Race in Bay

Sunday, May 31 - One (1) mixed-leg race off Ocean View

Racing begins at 10:00am each day.

The Low Point Scoring System will be used; 1 throw-out if at least 6 races completed.

Skippers' Mandatory registration and Skippers' Meeting on Thursday

Meeting: May 28, 2015, at 7:00PM under the tent adjacent to Hampton Yacht Club. Final fleet splits and sub-divisions will be announced at this time.

Awards-Social: Daily awards for each course will be given at the post-race party under the tent. A Boat of the Day award will be given for each course each day. On Saturday and Sunday, the Cruising Fleet also will be awarded a Boat of the Day award. Overall series awards plus the Black Seal Trophy (Boat of the Regatta) will be presented following racing Sunday. Social activities including food and music will be under the tent each day. Opening night social (Thursday, May 28, 2015) under the tent from 6:00PM until 9:00PM
