NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by Canadian Yachting Association, The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, and the Viper 640 Class Association Rules. The most important rule is have Fun and sail Fast!

2. Eligibility

The regatta will be open to all Viper 640 sailboats that comply with class rules. All skippers must be members of the Viper 640 Class Association. Join the Class at: <http://www.viper640.org/class/join-the-class/>

3. Entry Fee

\$50 payable at registration

4. Schedule of Events

Saturday, Aug 29 Check in and registration 0830 – 1000
1100 warning for first race, others to follow
Drinks and some food to follow

Sunday, Aug 30th 1000 warning for first race
No races will be started AFTER 1400
Awards will be presented and snacks provided as soon as possible after racing

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at check-in

6. Racing Area

- The racing area will be in a northeast direction from the SYC Harbour entrance approximately 1 – 1.5 miles from the entrance
- Courses will be windward/leeward of a length to be determined by the Principal Race Officer. The desired leg length will be $\frac{3}{4}$ - 1 mile in length as conditions allow.

7. Scoring

- The series will consist of as many races as possible within the allotted time.
- The low point scoring system RRS A2 shall apply
- If 7 or more races are completed the boats worst score will be thrown-out.
- A DSQ may not be thrown out.
- One race completed shall constitute a regatta



8. Awards

Awards will be presented to boats finishing first through third place..

9. Launch and Docking

Launch, haul and docking are all available on-site and included in the entry fee for all competitors.
