







Noroton Yacht Club is hosting the 2022 Women's Atlantic Coast Championship (WACC), United in the Race to Protect the World's Oceans, on June 24-26, 2022, in partnership with the Viper 640 International Class Association and Sailors for the Sea, presented by Bacardi Limited and our generous sponsors.



The Viper 640 is a high-performance sport boat raced at the national and international level by a crew of 3 or 4 sailors.

Noroton Yacht Club is on Long island Sound in Darien, one hour north of New York City. Competing teams registered from both sides af the Atlantic including USA, Canada, Spain and the UK.

Great Racing

The Racing Area is a short sail from the mouth of Noroton Bay, approx half an hour from the dock.

Racing starts at 11.30 am on Saturday and 10.00 am on Sunday. We aim to try and achieve three to four races per day.

The prevailing wind in June at Noroton is from the South West and the mean average daylight wind speed is 8-12 knots.

Our PRO is Glenn Morrison, an experienced race officer and Viper sailor.

Teams shall have a woman as helm and may either have mixed gender or all women crew.

- Friday at 6.00pm, Harbor start for Notoron's weekly one-design beer can race (for those that have completed registration)
- Saturday: A Class Coach Boat will provide On-The-Water Coaching in accordance with IVCA Rule 10.3 (b)
- Between races the Class Ccoach boat will be in the start area to provide observations and helpful tips to any competitors on request, with an emphasis on sail trim and boat handling for newcomers.
- On Saturday evening, we will provide a debrief accompanied by images on a big screen
